



LLPOA Speed Table Ballot Count Nov. 8, 2025

In Attendance

Board Members in Attendance: Bill Keel, Barbara Tilley, Elberta McKnight, Cindy Post and Shannon Meadows. Residents were invited but did not attend.

Summary

LLPOA board members met at Nelson City Hall on Saturday, Nov. 8, 2025, to tabulate ballots received for a speed bump recommendation to be given to City of Nelson Mayor Sylvia Green. The ballots were mailed to the community on Oct. 8, 2025, with a Nov. 7, 2025, return deadline.

A total of 60 votes were cast; each ballot was verified to be authentic.

The final tabulation favored property owners who are against the installation of speed tables. The vote total was: Against – 31, For – 29. More than half of the Laurel Lake community participated in the vote. The LLPOA will retain the ballots for three years.

Conclusion

The results were posted on the Laurel Lake Facebook page and given to City of Nelson Mayor Sylvia Green.

It is important to note the City of Nelson maintain the streets (curb-to-curb) throughout Laurel Lake. Therefore, the City of Nelson has the ultimate authority to decide whether speed tables are placed in our community. The LLPOA held the vote to give residents a voice on this very important issue. The 2025-2026 LLPOA board promised residents a community vote on this matter at the beginning of their term.

Bill reminded all in attendance our next board meeting is Dec. 9 and the special session was concluded.
